



VSA FALL 2010 TEAM MANAGER INFORMATION

I want to thank you for your help in supporting your soccer club this season. We couldn't run this league without the support of all of our volunteers. **Coaches will have your roster and other information for distribution to your team.**

League policy states there needs to be at least two adults present at all games and practices until all children have been picked up. If parents are not remaining at the field where their child is practicing they need to let the coach or designated adult know where they will be. Please advise all of your parents of this during practice.

For information about cancellations due to weather, you can check the VSA website, www.vsaonline.org, with cancellation information after 7:00 am on Saturday and after 3:00 pm during the week. All families will also be emailed if the fields are closed.

Refreshments can be provided for every game. A snack schedule is provided on the website (Team Manager Section) for you to fill out and give to each parent. If possible, do not schedule the coaches for refreshments, although some of them will offer and want to bring refreshments. Only water is allowed on the turf fields. No other food or drink.

Picture day this season will be Oct 23, 2010. The location will be announced on the website. Due to the size of the league there will be two locations, so pay attention to where your pictures will be taken. Pictures will be rain or shine. Envelopes and information should be handed out to parents one week before picture day. Please check www.vsaonline.org for the picture schedule 2 weeks before pictures are scheduled.

I will have pictures and trophies ready for pick-up on November 6, 2010. I will have the trophies and pictures at either the basketball court or the large pavilion. If the games are rained out, trophies and pictures will be available on November 13, 2010, which would be the last game. Check the website for updates.

At the end of the season, many teams plan small parties to hand out trophies, pictures and gifts. A gift for the coach and assistant coach are not required, this is up to the parents. The parents look to the team parent for planning of these events.
